



## Hall of Fame Procedures

### ***Nomination Procedures***

Any person associated with the Greater Los Angeles Softball Association (GLASA) for a minimum of 10 years can be nominated for the Hall of Fame. The nominee, whether living or deceased, should have made significant contributions to GLASA, its teams, or its members. The living members of the GLASA Hall of Fame (HoF) and the HoF Committee vote on the nominees each year, based on the credentials presented within the applications. The candidate who receive at least two-thirds (2/3) of the votes cast are then inducted into the GLASA Hall of Fame at awards ceremony at the end of the spring / summer season.

- Nominations will be accepted beginning September 1<sup>st</sup> (start of the fiscal year)
- Nominations will close on the first Sunday of May
- Voting meeting to take place within one week after the closing of nominations

### ***Nomination Criteria***

Any person associated with GLASA, living or deceased, (including players, non-player members, managers, coaches, scorekeepers, sponsors and umpires), who have made significant contributions to their team and/or GLASA and also who have been in the association for at least ten years are eligible for nomination to the GLASA HoF.

The application may be submitted by any active GLASA member or Hall of Fame member who is familiar with the candidate. We strongly recommend that the application include a photograph of the nominee. The reason for the photo is that names do not always convey the person nominated. The photo will become the property of the GLASA Hall of Fame.

The voting members may vote for as many of the nominees as they wish. A nominee must be selected on at least two-thirds (2/3rds) of the ballots cast to become a member of the GLASA Hall of Fame. The Chair of the GLASA HoF Committee will tabulate the results of the voting, and notify the nominees, the GLASA Executive Board, and the living Hall of Fame candidates of the results. The other nominees will carry over to the following year for consideration. After two years of consideration, the nominee will fall off the selection process and would need to be re-nominated for future consideration.

The selected Inductees will be invited as a guest of the League to attend the end of the season spring awards banquet to receive their GLASA HoF award. Their name, biography, and/or photo will appear on the GLASA website and will become eligible to vote on the selection of future HoF inductees.

***Voting Members***

- The living elected members of the GLASA Hall of Fame
- The current GLASA HoF committee members

***Hall of Fame Committee***

- The Chair of this committee shall be appointed by the GLASA Commissioner.
- The committee shall consist of no more than nine (9) good-standing and active members as appointed by the Chair and GLASA Commissioner
- GLASA HoF committee members are requested to serve a minimum of one full year starting September 1<sup>st</sup> through the spring season ending banquet.
- The chairman will assign duties to members of the committee

***Hall of Fame Committee Criteria***

Any good standing member with a minimum of 5 years within the League can be considered for the GLASA HoF committee.
